GFirst launches Barton Jobs Hub

Job seekers in Gloucestershire can get advice from a new Jobs Hub which launches in Barton next week.

The Jobs Hub, run by economic development company GFirst, will provide employment, careers and training support and advice. Qualified advisors will be on hand to help with everything from the jobs search to writing CVs, career coaching, retraining help and it gives free access to the internet.

It will take place at Barton Enterprise Centre at 99, Barton Street, Gloucester, on Tuesday January 24 from 1pm until 5pm and it is open to anyone aged 19 or over, regardless of their level of qualification, employment status or where they live.

The hub will then be held every Tuesday at the same venue and time.

Chief Executive of GFirst David Owen said: "Getting a job is a big issue for people not only in Gloucestershire but around the UK. At GFirst we want to give people in the county the best chance of getting employment and our Jobs Hubs are centred around giving people the skills they need to get the right job for them. They are open to people that are unemployed and those in employment and will cover the basics including writing CVs and how to conduct a jobs search to more in depth coaching and retraining advice."

GFirst also runs Jobs Hubs between 9am and 5pm at Gloucester Library on Mondays, The Gateway in Matson on Wednesdays, GL Communities YPod Cafe in Scott Avenue, Gloucester, on Thursdays and Herbert Warehouse, Gloucester Docks, on Fridays.
